

Boxy Stars Workshop!

Class Supply List

This quick star block is made from scrap 2 1/2" strips!



I made 12 quick star blocks for a bright and fun snuggle-sized quilt.
approximate size: 54"X68".



These stars are fun and easy to make with no set in seams. Each 12" block is made from four 6" block quarters.

For each block quarter we will be cutting the following:



(3) 2.5" squares of background fabric.

(all 4 block quarters for each star can be a different background, but I kept the background the same within each quarter.)

Accent pieces:

(1) 2.5" square and (1) 2.5" X 4.5" rectangle.

Star points:

(1) 2.5" X 4.5" rectangle and (1) 2.5" X 6.5" rectangle.

The quilt above uses 48 block quarters to make 12 blocks!

If you want the "star" to come forward out of one fabric, just make 4 block quarters the same!

It is not necessary that you cut all these pieces ahead of time, but you are welcome to if you want to! If you would rather, just bring dark, medium and light scraps cut into 2.5" strips. We can mix and match them as we go, and cut the squares and rectangles as we make the blocks.

If every one brings an assortment of 2.5" strips, we can trade with each other for more variety!

Other fabrics needed:

Sashing, cornerstone and border fabrics as desired. Amounts may vary depending on the size of quilt you make.



General Supplies needed:

Sewing machine in working order (including power cords and extension cords)

Thread, scissors, seam ripper, pins and any other notions you usually sew with.

Rotary cutter, mat and ruler. My favorite size is 6.5" X 12.5"

We will also need ironing stations. A large cutting table at proper height is helpful.
