## Crazy Scrappy Fun, and NO TRIANGLES!

Put those precious scraps to work for you with a fun and simple block perfect for mixing and matching from simple strips and squares. Easy rotary cutting and simple patchwork make this pattern ideal for beginners, with pressing tips for perfect results! Let your imagination run wild with fabric and color placement as you play with light and dark values. And remember, if the fabric is still ugly, you just didn't cut it small enough!

Quilt with ALL of your scraps!
For this workshop, you will need:
Sewing machine in working order with all cords, foot pedal and patchwork foot.
Rotary cutter with new blade, small mat and ruler. (Both a $61 / 2^{\prime \prime \prime}$ square and a $21 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ X $61 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ small ruler is helpful.)

Wooden pressing tool if individual irons are not allowed.
Thread, pins, seam ripper, fabric scissors and anything you would normally use while sewing at a workshop.
**OPTIONAL** The hour-glass connector blocks can be easily cut from 3-1/2" strips using my Essential Triangle Tool, or can be made with traditional rotary cutting methods from squares. Rulers will be available in class at a discount. I will be demoing different ways to do the Hour Glass Connector block.

Pre-cutting:

## Chunky Churn Dash Blocks:

This darling quilt has 61 Chunky Churn Dash Blocks and was made using strips from the $1.5^{\prime \prime}$ bin and the $2.5^{\prime \prime}$ bin. The centers for the blocks came from the bin of light scrap $2.5^{\prime \prime}$ squares, though you could just as easily cut them from your strips if you wanted.


For each Chunky Churn Dash block you will need:
$1.5^{\prime \prime} \times 11^{\prime \prime}$ strip of background
$1.5^{\prime \prime} \times 11^{\prime \prime}$ strip of 'rail' fabric
(4) $2.5^{\prime \prime}$ squares for block corners
(1) $2.5^{\prime \prime}$ center background square (can be scrappy or can match the other background strip.)

Pieces can be pinned, clipped, or stored in zip lock bags as "kits."
Please come with enough block "kits" to keep you busy during the class time given. Each block is made with two colored fabrics, and a neutral.

Go for variety! And we can swap strips for maximum scrappiness!
You may want to wait to choose yardage for this part until you see how your blocks look and then choose something to go with them.

If you already know what you would like, plan on $13 / 4$ yards of dark, and $13 / 4$ yards of light yardage, or you could go scrappy.
