## Moth in the Window

**Class Supply List** 



Finished block size: 8"

Finished quilt size: 88 1/2" X 88 1/2"

Work with recycled fabrics or scrap stash, it's up to you!

Sew a basket full of Moth in the Window blocks from strips and squares.

Easy rotary cutting, and simple patchwork make this pattern ideal for beginners, with pressing tips for perfect results!

Let your imagination run wild with fabric and color placement as you play with light and dark values.

Pair strips and cut with the Essential Triangle Tool for half square triangles ready to sew.

For this workshop you will need:

\*Addicted to Scraps Book by Bonnie Hunter

\*Essential Triangle tool by Bonnie Hunter

Sewing machine in working order with all cords, foot pedal and patchwork foot.

Extra Ott light, classroom light is not always the best. Better to be prepared!

Rotary cutter with new blade and small mat,

6 1/2" x 12 1/2" ruler (or 6" x 12")

Thread, pins, seam ripper, fabric scissors and anything you would normally use while sewing at a workshop.

Wooden pressing tool if individual irons are not allowed.

Please bring zip lock baggies to keep yourself organized with this class!

Yardage Requirements:

The total required for this top before quilting is given for planning purposes. Please cut just enough to keep you busy during the designated class time.

Light, Medium to Dark Scraps: 8 1/4 yards total for blocks and border.

Orange plaid: 1/4 yard for cornerstones.

Burgundy Stripe: 1 3/8 yards for sashing

Black Solid: 3 yards for sashing, outer border and binding.

White/black check: 5/8 yard for inner border.

Pre-cutting:

Please come with block "kits" to keep you busy during the class time given.

Each block is made with TWO complimentary fabrics.

Cutting and kitting for ONE block:

From background fabric, cut 2 strips from the SAME FABRIC: 1 strip 1 1/2" x 32" or (2 1 1/2" strips from a fat quarter) 1 strip 2 1/2" x 12" for center triangles and squares.

From Moth & Window Fabric cut 2 pieces from the same fabric: 1 strip 1 1/2" x 32" or (2 1 1/2" strips from a fat quarter) 1 rectangle 2 1/2" x 6 1/2"

We will be using the Essential Triangle Tool for the half-square triangles in the block from the 2 1/2" strips you have cut above.

Place each block kit in a zip lock bag.

Those who wait to cut during class may be left behind!

If our workshop is being hosted by a quilt shop, the quilt shop will be carrying my merchandise. I will not be bringing books or tools with me.

If our workshop is hosted by a guild, a show or at a retreat, I will have merchandise on hand or on my website at Quiltville.com/shop.html.
