Finished block size: 12"

Finished quilt size: 78 1/2" X 98 1/2"

Quilt a scraptastic rainbow of colorful stars

Put those precious scraps to work for you with a dazzling quilt pattern from best-selling author Bonnie K. Hunter. Sew a field of wonky stars atop colorful scrappy squares and low-volume, string-pieced sashing. Easy rotary cutting and simple patchwork make this pattern ideal for beginners, with pressing tips for perfect results! Let your imagination run wild with fabric and color placement as you play with light and dark values. And remember, if the fabric is still ugly, you just didn't cut it small enough!

• Quilt with all of your scraps! Pair wonky star blocks with string-pieced sashing for a kaleidoscopic effect

- Slice and sew—no templates required! Includes pressing tips for picture-perfect piecing
- Popular quilter and author Bonnie Hunter teaches you to sort fabrics by value

For this workshop you will need:


Sewing machine in working order with all cords, foot pedal and patchwork foot.

Rotary cutter with new blade, small mat and ruler. (Both a 6 1/2" square and a 6 1/2" by 12 1/2" rectangle are helpful.)

Wooden pressing tool if individual irons are not allowed.

Thread, pins, seam ripper, fabric scissors and anything you would normally use while sewing at a workshop.

Foundation paper for string piecing. Phone book pages, doodle pad or legal size paper piecing paper work great.



Wonky Wishes Pattern

The Wonky Wishes pattern retails at \$11.95 will be available from me on my website or in class for \$10.00. Each student must have their own copy of the pattern, no sharing, and no photocopies. This is your text book.

Yardage requirements:

Assorted dark scraps in a variety of colors: 5 yards total.

Assorted light/neutral scraps from white to cream to beige: 6 3/4 yards total

Pre-cutting:

This is a 4 or 6-hour workshop. There is no way that you will need to cut out the entire quilt ahead of time. Bring enough to keep you busy during

class time. Full cutting given below for planning purposes:

Star centers: 120 light/neutral 2 1/2" squares

Star backgrounds: 960 assorted dark 2 1/2" squares

Star points: 480 2 1/2" light/neutral squares sliced on the diagonal from corner to corner into 960 halfsquare triangles. *Note* if you have small leftover neutral scraps and cut-off triangles from other projects, these may be used in place of the star point triangles. They do not have to be precisely cut to cover the corner of a base square.

Neutral Strings: Narrow strips of fabric from 3/4" wide up to 2" wide for string pieced sashing. We will spend a small segment of time of string piecing. Cut enough to get you going, you can cut more as needed.

And the best part of all? ALL OF THESE items can be swapped and traded in class with others to increase our variety, and our FUN!
