Scrap Crystals Class Supply List

Block Size: 12"
Finished Quilt: 75" X 90"

A box of blue \& Neutral bonus triangles, a bin of 2" cut squares. A desire to sew on my 1911 treadle machine! That's all it took for me to start building simple broken dishes units as Leaders \& Enders in between the lines of other projects. This is the result!
**NOTE** This is a book-required class. The pattern is found in my book "MORE Adventures with Leaders \& Enders." You must bring your book with you, no photocopies are allowed due to Copyright law.

Full quilt yardage is given below for your planning, but keep in mind that you likely won't need to bring your sashing, binding and border fabrics to class. Consider the time we have for class, and perhaps just bring a bit more than you think you will accomplish in that period of time!

My preferred method for scrappy half square triangles uses the Easy Angle ruler and 2" strips for the half-square triangles in this quilt. If you wish to use any OTHER triangle method, please do not cut your fabric into 2" strips ahead of time. This is size specific to the Easy Angle ruler. You can use any method that gives you 2 " half-square triangles units that finish at 1.5 " in the quilt. With regular rotary cutting, these are generally cut from $2-3 / 8$ " squares.

Yardage requirements for blocks: ALL FABRICS ARE SCRAPPY! VARIETY IS IMPORTANT!

Total green scraps needed for blocks: 1-1/4 yard.
Total Blue scraps needed for star points: 2 yards.
Total neutral scraps as backgrounds: $2-1 / 2$ yards
My neutrals include EVERYTHING! Small prints, plaids stripes, shirtings, novelties and tone on tones all on a white, cream, beige or tan background - no darker than paper bag brown. Clean out those scraps and prepare to have fun with some really scrappy backgrounds!

Don't like blue/green? Choose ANY two colors that you like together to replace them, along with ANY background.

Green sashing: 1-1/2 yards
Blue sashing: 1 yard
Outer border: 1-1/2 yards.
Binding: 3/4 yard.

## Pre-Cutting:

- From green blue and neutral scraps, cut 2" strips. Bring enough for class time.
**Note** the 2" strip width is for working with the Easy Angle Ruler. If you plan on any other method for your half- square triangles this strip width may not work for you. Plan accordingly. Triangle units will measure 2 " and finish at 1.5 " in the quilt.

Other things to bring to class:

- Machine in good working order ((These are supplied on cruises, if cruising disregard!))
- Thread, pins, seam ripper, scissors - everything you would need to sew at home.
- Rotary cutter and ruler and small mat-
- Easy Angle Ruler for cutting triangles (I will have some on hand for purchase)
