



Quiltville Inn Retreat

Frequently Asked Questions-

Where is Quiltville Inn?

You will find us in the Southwestern corner of Virginia, a mere 3 miles from the VA/NC state line. Mouth of Wilson, VA is about 3 hours' drive north of Charlotte NC, 2 hours' drive from Roanoke, VA, 2 hours' drive from Greensboro NC and 1 1/2 hours' drive from Bristol, TN. These cities host our nearest airports, with Charlotte being the largest.

How do I reserve dates for my group?

Current groups have the first right of refusal on their same weekend the following year. When openings happen due to any group not rebooking for whatever reason I am contacting groups in the order that entries come in to fill vacancies.

With a limited number of retreat dates and many more groups than we can possibly accommodate, we are currently adding groups to our waiting list for future available retreat openings.

The newly booked group may also keep that weekend the following year if they wish to rebook. Should they not, we again will pull the next group off of the waiting list to book that available weekend.

What types of payment do you accept?

A rental agreement and a \$500.00 deposit payable by check will be emailed to you upon the reserving of your retreat dates. This deposit must be paid, and your contract signed, scanned and emailed back with your check within 14 days of issue to lock in your dates.

If your rental agreement and deposit are not received after 14 days, another group may reserve your dates.

Check or money orders are accepted for your deposit and balance (No credit cards.) Balance must be received 30 days prior to your check-in date. Please make sure to designate a single person to act as the

point of contact for your group reservation and to handle all payments. We cannot accept individual payments from each member of your retreat party.

Are you Handicap Accessible?

Quiltville Inn is a Victorian home built in 1884. All bedrooms are on the second floor and we have many steps. Guests must be able to climb stairs. Thank you for understanding that we cannot accommodate all visitors due to preserving the historic architecture of Quiltville Inn.

What about meals?

Your group will have access to the fully equipped Quiltville Inn kitchen. The kitchen contains all of the needed appliances, bakeware, crockpots, coffee pots and dishes/utensils you need to prepare your own meals. Just bring the food and beverages! There are a couple of mini-marts, a bistro and also a diner that serves breakfast/lunch and dinner within a few miles of the inn. Groceries may be picked up on your way to retreat in nearby towns.

How many people can stay?

Quiltville Inn will host 12 people. There are 4 guest bedrooms, each with 3 beds. We have 3 baths with walk-in showers. Your rental of the house is a flat fee. No unpaid visitors or “day campers” beyond the 12 people under contract are allowed. The house is rented as a whole, and the price is the same whether you have 2 people or 12. You will want to fill your group for the most economical rate per person.

What time is check out/check in?

Our base retreat is a 10 am Thursday arrival to 11:00am Sunday departure. (3 nights.) Additional stays of Sunday night and Monday night may also be added with 11:00am checkout the following day. Early arrival after 4pm on Wednesday is also an option for groups traveling from farther away.

Are children allowed?

Due to the age of the house and its vicinity to the highway, and the creek that runs behind, and since quilting involves sharp instruments and hot irons guests must be at least 18 years of age.

What about pets?

While we do have our cat mascots living outside on the porch, No guest pets are allowed. Thank you for understanding that folks within your group, and folks in the groups after you may have allergies to inside animals.
