This post contains the back story, colors, yardage requirements, and recommended tools.

Our yearly Quiltville Winter Mystery begins in earnest with Part One going live on - PLEASE READ - NOVEMBER 21, 2025!

Yes, I know that is a week early - but I leave for Germany on Black Friday - and we are getting an early start while we can.

Of course, this may all change due to what is going on with Jason and his recovery so please be flexible with me over the course of this mystery. We may skip a week. We may double up on parts the next week. At this point I'm just going with the flow as we play whack-a-mole with this thing.

If you are one of the many, many new ones who are joining in for the first time, I want to welcome you.

The most important thing I can mention is to PRINT YOUR PDF COPIES (or save them to your device, cloud, whatever) as they are released. I can't recommend a site like Dropbox or Google Docs highly enough.

When the mystery retires, likely some time in February - all of these mystery posts will go away, and I will not be providing missing parts. You'll be directed to the Quiltville Store to purchase the pattern. SAVE YOUR CLUES.

Why do we do a mystery quilt during the holidays? It's simple.

My Craftours group in Iceland!

June 2025

Yes, it was a bit windy and cold, but we were all enamored with the lupine - everywhere there was lupine!

The controversial Lupine is not native to Iceland but was introduced in the 1940s to help with soil erosion. Since then, it has spread like a weed all around Iceland and has proven difficult to control. Depending on who you ask, they're either a welcome addition of color to the Icelandic landscape or an absolute menace!

I'll throw in my two cents - I'll take Lupine over Kudzu any day!

I'll be sharing more photos from things we saw and did in Iceland as we work our way through the mystery.

Our Lupine & Laughter quilt finishes at 80" X 80'. You can make it bigger or change it to a rectangle by adding more blocks and/or adding more borders. You can make it smaller by making fewer blocks.

Colors & Yardage Requirements:



Purples. Pinks, Ice Blue & Neutral!



Back of Paint Chips.

(See back of this pdf for full sized images)

The purples and pinks are there to show you the RANGE of shades in my quilt. You can push your color families any direction you want. Do not over-match your colors but let them vary.



Purples contain many red-purples to bluepurples. Of course, these purples are from the colors of the lupine!



Ice blue is more blue than aqua - I was thinking of the color of the water we encountered at the Blue Lagoon out of Reykjavik:



Yes, it is that blue!



The Blue Lagoon is a geothermal seawater pool known for its high mineral content, including silica and algae, which gives the water its iconic milky-blue color.



Pinks from light baby pink to magenta and some pushing toward peachy-pink:



Along with the Lupine, there are wildflowers in a variety of pinks as well. This one is called Sea Thrift.



And this sweet beauty is called Ice Moss.



A wide variety of fun neutrals - more white, less creamy.



Inspired by the Mountain Avens, so pretty.

Yardage Requirements:

Purples: 2 1/4 yards

Pinks: 2 yards


Ice Blue: 1 3/4 yards

Neutral: 4 1/4 yards

Please note that if you choose any construction method that has you going bigger to sliver trim

down that more fabric will be required.

Specialty Rulers:



Half-Rectangle Trim Tool

Lupine & Laughter has us working with a newto-us unit! While I will provide paper-piecing templates for any weird-angle units as in the past, I love this ruler for quick piecing, easy trimming of half-rectangle units. Highly recommend!



My Essential Triangle Tool.



Simple Folded Corners ruler – either large

Or the Simple Folded Corners mini.



Ultimate 3-in-1 Color tool.

I love this tool for helping with color recipes that WORK! If you don't want to sew with my 3 colors – this tool will help you choose what goes with what in a very simple way.

You don't need to be a color wizard to choose a knock-out color plan.

To use a coupon code - click REDEEM YOUR COUPON beneath the total in the shopping cart. Enter the coupon code in the box that opens up. Click enter.

NOTE You need to put the code in BEFORE you click to your payment method for discount coupon to be applied. Do not click to your payment until coupon code is entered.

I will provide traditional rotary cutting measurements for those who wish to work that way.

I will not be giving Accuquilt die information as it reveals too much too soon. As each clue comes out with each given finished unit size, you can easily find the corresponding die you need.

So there you have it. You have roughly 4 weeks to pull your fabrics together.

We start with PART ONE on Friday, November 21st - the Friday BEFORE Thanksgiving here in the USA.

Let's Do This! Oh, and one last thing:



What's my number 1 rule?

No whining!

This will be a learning experience for many, but I know you can do this. I will present alternate methods for you to do the units. Try them all and choose the one that works for you.

This is a time to slow down, find out where piecing problems may be coming from, make a change, develop new habits with better results. You've got this!
