Class Supply List



Finished Block: 10"

Finished Quilt: 70"x 80"

For this workshop you will need:

*String Frenzy Book by Bonnie Hunter

Sewing machine in working order with all cords, foot pedal and patchwork foot.

Optional: An "open toe" foot is also helpful with string piecing if your 1/4" foot has a guide on the side that likes to catch paper when sewing on foundations.

Extra Ott light, classroom light is not always the best. Better to be prepared!

Rotary cutter with new blade, small mat and 6 1/2"x 12 1/2" ruler.

Optional: 12 1/2" square ruler for squaring blocks.

Thread, pins, seam ripper, fabric scissors and anything you would normally use while sewing at a workshop.

Wooden pressing tool if individual irons are not allowed.

Foundation paper: (Doodle pad, paper piecing paper, phone book pages, any paper you like may be used.)

115 squares 7 3/4" x 7 3/4" are needed for the full quilt, but if you come with 18 for the day you should be good to go.

Template plastic – trace the kite shape on page 90 with a file point sharpie and cut out and bring to class.

Fabric requirements below are for the full quilt for planning purposes only, you don't need to bring this much to class – Just bring enough to keep you busy for the 6 hours of class time.

Yellow Solid (Background) 3 yards for kites

Assorted Scraps from light to dark 6 1/2 yards for string piecing.

Cut fabric scraps in a variety of widths from 3/4" to 2". Strips can lean and taper for more variety, no precise measuring is needed. Please due this BEFORE class so valuable class time is not wasted with strip cutting.

We can swap strips with each other and share for more variety, more fun!

If I am teaching for a guild or show event, books are available from me and will be on hand for purchase at the event.
