

Strip Twist Class Supply List



General Supplies needed:

Block size: Approximately 15" finished.
Quilt Size – up to you!

Easy rotary cutting and simple patchwork make this pattern ideal for beginners, with pressing tips for perfect results!

Let your imagination run wild with fabric and color placement as you play with light and dark values. And remember, if the fabric is still ugly, you just didn't cut it small enough!

For this workshop you will also need:

Sewing machine in working order with all cords, foot pedal and patchwork foot.

Rotary cutter with new blade, small mat and 6" x 12" ruler. A 9" or larger square is also VERY helpful.

Wooden pressing tool if individual irons are not allowed.

Thread, pins, seam ripper, fabric scissors and anything you would normally use while sewing at a workshop.

Workshop Fabric Supplies:

This is a quilt perfect for using up all those 2.5" strips you've been saving. Jelly rolls work, but what I'd really love is not for anyone to have to go buy anything. We've got more scraps than we know what to do with, right?

What makes it extra fun is sharing fabrics with each other, so bring extra strips to share!

As you prepare for this workshop, plan on spending a bit of time each day pressing and cutting your scraps into 2.5" strips. You can plan a color theme if you want, or you can go "kitchen sink" and throw in everything!

Please include lights, mediums and darks in this quilt for interest.

NOTE

Strips NEED to be at least 9" long..... or go 18" long and get 2 sub-cuts per strip set) So this works really well to cut strips from Fat Quarters too.

Maybe you've got some that you've been waiting for the "RIGHT" project to use them?

Those who wait to cut during class may be left behind!

Class time is for learning. Please do not jump ahead and sew at home before the workshop. You may miss something significant if you do!
