Quilt Size: 72.5" X 82.5"
Block Size: 9"
This is the PERFECT quilt for digging into that scrap bag and putting it to good use! Easy enough for confident beginners and fun enough for even advanced piecers, we'll be having a great time sewing with scrap 1.5 " strips, trading with each other to get more variety in our fabrics, and adding half square triangles to the mix.

This is a "book required" class. Books can be purchased ahead of time at http://quiltville.com or I will bring plenty with me.

Also helpful: Easy Angle Ruler. I use the Easy Angle Ruler for making my $1 / 2$ square triangles from 3.5" strips. If you have a different method you like ((Thangles, triangles on a roll, other rulers, sew big, trim down)) that's fine too, bring it along. The more favorite methods we can talk about and see in action, the more tools it puts in our tool boxes as quilters.

Fabric Requirements:

We will get as much done as we can in class, but it is unlikely you will finish the whole quilt in one day. Please bring enough to sew with for the day.

For blocks and outer border:

4 yards of assorted light scraps

4 yards of assorted dark scraps
For Cornerstones:

1/4 yard assorted blue scraps

For Inner Borders: 3/4 yard of assorted red scraps.
Pre-Cutting for Class:
The 9 patch units are strip pieced from 1.5" strips. Please come with a variety of scraps cut into $1.5^{\prime \prime}$ strips in both dark and light values. Cut some extra to trade!

If you are wanting to try the Easy Angle Ruler method for doing half square triangles, come with some of your dark and light fabrics cut into $3.5^{\prime \prime}$ strips. We can trade these in class also.
